

January 2024 Move-In Information

Welcome to South Campus Quarter! The information provided below is designed to help your move-in process go smoothly. All documents referenced are also available on our website. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 513-523-1647 or office@southcampusquarter.com.

Move-In Date

• Your lease start date is listed in your lease. Please call 513-523-1647 to schedule a move-in appointment. Our office will be closed December 22 through January 2, 2024. Regular office hours are Monday through Friday, 9am to 5pm, and Saturdays by appointment only. All appointments must be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Payment

- Spring Semester rent is due on January 1, 2024. You will not be permitted to pick up keys if either your or your roommates' rent is not paid. Mail rent payment to: South Campus Quarter, P.O. Box 622, Hamilton, OH 45012. Checks must be received in the office prior to key pickup.
- South Campus Quarter has extended the rent due date from January 1 to January 15, 2024. You are welcome to take advantage of this extension. The only requirement is that all rent is paid prior to key pick up.
- If you are using **Financial Aid** to pay your semester rent and need extra time to allow for disbursement of your funds, you must obtain written approval from South Campus Quarter. We must receive official written documentation from your financial institution **prior** to December 15, 2023. Once we've received documentation, we will provide you with a <u>Financial Aid Rent Payment Addendum</u> to sign and return to our office within 48 hours. *Failure to complete this process will result in South Campus Quarter being unable to grant extra time for payment*. Financial aid extensions apply only to tenants paying the full semester rent (not monthly payments). Prior tenants of South Campus Quarter must re-apply each year for the deferment.

Utilities

Required utilities must remain in a tenants' name throughout entire lease period (both semesters). Tenants
should contact vacating tenants to arrange transfer of service if necessary. Written proof of transfer must be
shown before any keys will be issued. See the Utility Information page for more information.

Parking

- Campus Courts, Bern Street, and 308 S. Campus Ave. Apartments: Tenants must obtain a valid parking permit
 to park in their designated lot. Please review our <u>Annual Parking Registration & Lottery Form</u> and <u>Parking Rules</u>
 and <u>Regulations</u> for a complete explanation of the procedure. Parking forms must be returned by <u>December</u>
 15, 2023 or you will forfeit your free spot. Towing of the lots will be suspended during move-in, with the
 exception of the maintenance only parking spaces and fire lanes. You will be notified when towing resumes.
- Campus Commons Duplexes: Parking in front of Campus Commons on Rose, Bern, Poplar, and Wooster streets is 24/7 City of Oxford Residential Permit Parking (RPP). You must have a valid permit to park here at any time. The City will not issue new passes without an old pass being turned in, and will not issue replacements for lost or stolen passes. If you are interested in street parking, you may want to check with the other tenants in your unit to see if they have passes, or with SCQ to see if any passes have been turned in by vacating tenants. You can also check with the city to see if they have any available passes. See the Campus Commons Parking Information page for more information.
